CITY ORDINANCE NO. 44, SERIES OF 2000

“AN ORDINANCE GRANTING THE CHILD FRIENDLY BARANGAY AWARD TO DESERVING BARANGAYS IN THE CITY OF TAGUM AND PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION THEREOF.”

BE IT enacted by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Tagum in Session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. There shall be established the Child Friendly Barangay Award to deserving barangays in the City of Tagum.

SECTION II. For the effective implementation of this program, there shall be a Local Technical Working Group to be organized to develop the search guidelines and criteria, by virtue of Child Welfare Council Circular No. 72, series of 1999.

SECTION III. All Barangays in the City of Tagum can join the search by means of the following:

- A 1 Letter of intent for joining
- B 2 Accomplishment of application form

SECTION V. The parameters to be used in selecting the awardees, shall be determined by the Local Technical Working Group, organized by the Tagum Council for the Welfare of Children.

SECTION VI. The Local Technical Working Group shall submit the names of Barangay in the office of the Local Chief Executive two weeks before the awards;

SECTION VII. FREQUENCY OF AWARD. The search shall be an annual award to be spearheaded by the Council for the Welfare of Children, and shall be granted by the Local Chief Executive or in his absence, the Vice Mayor or any member of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, every month of October known as the Children.'s Month.

SECTION VIII. APPROPRIATION. Budgetary requirements to support the implementation of this program shall be taken from the 20% development fund so warrant.

SECTION IX. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any Ordinance, orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION X. EFFECTIVITY. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
