**CITY ORDINANCE NO. 350, s-2009**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BY ADDITION LETTER D OF SECTION 102 AND ARTICLE A (REGULATORY FEES) OF TAX ORDINANCE NO. 07-001 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE 2007 REVENUE CODE OF THE CITY OF TAGUM.**

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Tagum in session assembled, that:

**SECTION 1**, This Ordinance shall amend by addition Letter D of Section 102 and Article A (Regulatory Fees) of Tax Ordinance No. 07-001 otherwise known as the 2007 Revenue Code of the City of Tagum.

**SECTION 2**, The provisions of this Ordinance shall govern the guidelines for the additional levy and collection of Security Fee (SF) in the City of Tagum.

**SECTION 3**, Section 102 of the 2007 Revenue Code of the City of Tagum which reads as follows:

“Section 102. Usage of Fees. These fees shall be used solely for the following purposes:

- a) Educational Support Program Fee (ESPF)
  1. Construction and Repair/Maintenance of School Buildings and Day Care Centers
  2. Construction and Maintenance of City Library
  3. Purchase of Reading Materials
  4. Fabrication of School chairs and Desks
  5. Scholarship Grants
  6. Information Technology
  7. Research and Development

- b) Drainage Maintenance Fee (DMF)
  - 1. Construction, Repair and Maintenance of Drainages
  - 2. Other Operating Expenses
- c) Road Maintenance Fee (RMF)
  - 1. Construction, Repair and Maintenance of Roads
  - 2. Other Operating Expenses
- d) Security Fee (SF)
  - 1. Peace and Order Program
  - 2. Other Operating Expenses
- e) Fire Safety Inspection Fee (FSIF)
  - 1. Purchase, repair and Maintenance of Fire Trucks
  - 2. Purchase of Fire Protective Gears
  - 3. Purchase of Lots for Fire Sub-Station
  - 4. Other Operating Expenses
- f) Sanitation Service Fee (SSF)
  - 1. Maintenance of Cleanliness of streets and public places
  - 2. Other Operating Expenses
- g) Garbage Fee (GF)
  - 1. Purchase, Repair and Maintenance of Garbage Trucks
  - 2. Other Operating Expenses
- h) Archival Fee (AF)
  - 1. Maintenance of Archival System
  - 2. Other Operating Expenses

shall be amended to read as follows:

“Section 102. Usage of Fees. These fees shall be used solely for the following purposes:

- a) Security Fee (SF)
  - 1. Peace and Order Program;
  - 2. Purchase of lot for the Philippine National Police building;
  - 3. Construction and maintenance of Philippine National Police building;
  - 4. Purchase and maintenance of surveillance cameras to be installed in the public places in the city;
  - 5. Purchases and maintenance of K9 dogs and training expense for the K9 dogs and personnel;
  - 6. Purchases and maintenance of mobile patrol vehicles;
  - 7. Purchases and maintenance of aircraft, watercraft and other equipment for coastal patrol;
  - 8. Purchases and maintenance of communication and IT equipment for the PNP, Barangay Police and other security personnel;
  - 9. Training Expenses for the officers and members of City Integrated Defense Unit (CIDU), a unit created through Executive Order No. 33, s-2008;
  - 10. Expenses relative to the improvement of police visibility;
  - 11. Training Expense for the Barangay Police;
  - 12. Other operating expenses of programs and projects relative to the maintenance of peace and order in the city.

**SECTION 4.** An additional provision shall be added in Article A (Regulatory Fees) of the 2007 Revenue Code of the City of Tagum which reads as follows:

“Section 102-A. Security Fee (SF) – a fee of Twenty Pesos (P 20.00) shall be imposed on any person, establishment or business entity for every transaction with the City Government of Tagum. However, cash tickets and payments for Monthly Stall Rental, Terminal/Toll Fees, Slaughterhouse/Livestock Fees at the Economic Enterprises are exempted from this fee”.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
