**RESOLUTION NO. 402, s-2008**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE NATIONAL FOOD AUTHORITY (NFA) TO AUTHORIZE TAGUM CITY EMPLOYEES COOPERATIVE (TACECO) TO OPERATE AS AN ACCREDITED OUTLET/RETAILER OF NATIONAL FOOD AUTHORITY (NFA) RICE.**

**WHEREAS**, Tagum City Employees Cooperative was founded 1994 with only P1,000.00 as a starting share capital and about 15 individuals as its original cooperators;

**WHEREAS**, over the years, Tagum City Employees Cooperative has grown to become a strong, viable cooperative for its growing members, with over Php11 Million Assets, 292 Members operating to date;

**WHEREAS**, one of the thrusts of the Tagum City Employees Cooperative is to provide good quality services to its members:

**WHEREAS**, the cooperative intends to expand its programs, projects and activities to meet the pressing demands of its members especially in providing goods and basic services during this critical situation due to the increasing prices of commodities which affect the economic condition of the city employees;

**WHEREAS**, the Board felt the need to respond immediately to this situation through application to the NFA for accreditation as an outlet/retailer of NFA rice which is affordable to our city employees as well as to our walk-in clients;

**WHEREAS**, Tagum City Employees Cooperative (TACECO) has manifested its intent to acquire legal recognition from the city government as embodied in its Board Resolution No. 5, s-2008 to operate as an outlet/retailer of NFA rice attested by Chairman, Ms. Edna J. Quilario, MPA;

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the 4<sup>th</sup> City Council of Tagum to request the National Food Authority (NFA) to authorize Tagum City Employees Cooperative (TACECO) to operate as an accredited outlet/retailer of National Food Authority (NFA) rice.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that copies of this resolution be furnished to Tagum City Employees Cooperative (TACECO) and all offices concerned for their information and guidance.
