RESOLUTION NO. 477, s-2008

A RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING THE TAGUM CITY LITERACY COORDINATING COUNCIL THROUGH ITS CHAIRMAN HONORABLE CITY MAYOR REY T. UY AND MEMBERS FOR HAVING BROUGHT HONOR AND PRIDE TO TAGUM CITY BEING ADJUDGED AS THE 2008 MOST OUTSTANDING LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT IN LITERACY PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION COMPONENT CITY CATEGORY IN THE PHILIPPINES.

WHEREAS, during the recently concluded National Literacy Conference and Awards held in Teachers Camp, Baguio City on September 17 – 19, 2008, the National Literacy Coordinating Council presented the result of its National Search and Evaluation on Outstanding Local Government Unit – Component City Category and adjudged the City of Tagum as Most Outstanding Local Government Unit in the implementation of Literacy Program in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, the Literacy Program of Tagum City is a regular program implemented through the City Literacy Coordinating Council chaired by the Local Chief Executive and co-chaired by the SP Chairman, Committee on Education, Hon. Raymond Joey D. Millan and the Schools Division Superintendent, Nenita E. Lumaad;

WHEREAS, Tagum City yielded 95.24% literacy rate in 2006 literacy mapping for people 10-80 years old. Also sustained and expanded the coverage of literacy projects, and has also maintained close collaboration with 20 NGOs in implementing its literacy projects and has organized 23 Barangay Literacy Coordinating Councils (BLCCs). It has also closely monitored all its literacy programs and projects and conducts regular evaluation together with the members of the Literacy Coordinating Council LCC) of Tagum City and its project implementers;

WHEREAS, among its banner literacy projects include the use of a new techno-van for learning sessions to promote mobile literacy, the use of media to promote political literacy which is enhanced by the translation of ordinances into the vernacular, Project REY (Reading Empowers Youth) which is a remedial program through reading clinics and its music literacy which produced a band with 1,000 members;

WHEREAS, such achievement award and recognition, is not only for Tagum City and Davao del Norte but also in the entire country, such award inspired greatly the people of Tagum in particular and the literacy program advocates/implementer in general;

WHEREAS, for and in behalf of the City Government of Tagum, Hon. Allan L. Rellon received the award during the awarding of the 2008 Most Outstanding Local Government Unit in Literacy Program Implementation – Component City Category in the Philippines at Baguio City.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the 4th City Council of Tagum to congratulate the Tagum City Literacy Coordinating Council through its Chairman Honorable City Mayor Rey T. Uy and members for having brought honor and pride to Tagum City being adjudged as the 2008 most outstanding Local Government Unit in Literacy Program Implementation component city category in the Philippines.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that this resolution be inscribed in a plaque and formally presented to the awardees in an appropriate occasion.
