RESOLUTION NO. 484 s-2008

“A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEVELOPMENT BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES FOR THE CITY OF TAGUM TO ENROLL IN THE DBP FOREST PROGRAM AND SECURE A FUNDING ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND (P 2,700,000.00) PESOS AS COUNTERPART FUNDS FOR THE MANGROVE REFORESTATION AND AQUACULTURE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM OF THE CITY OF TAGUM.”

WHEREAS, RA 8435 otherwise known as the Agriculture and Fisheries Modernization Act or AFMA aims to strengthen the Agriculture and Fishery sectors through modernization and greater participation among the Local Government Units (LGUs), farmers and fisherfolks, non-government organizations and people's organizations;

WHEREAS, three of the major thrusts of the city government under Hon. Rey T. Uy, City Mayor, are Environmental Protection and Reservation, Food Security & Sufficiency and Job Generation & Poverty Alleviation;

WHEREAS, the Development Bank of the Philippines, a Government-Owned and Controlled Bank, believes that the key to protecting and improving the environment is helping establish forests thereby preventing soil erosion, conserving water, providing habitat to wildlife, and creating rural livelihood opportunities;

WHEREAS, in the pursuit of its beliefs and its role in nation-building and as one of its vehicles in realizing its Corporate Social Responsibility towards the environment, the DBP activates its DBP Forest Program which also covers downstream industries in the rural areas and the rehabilitation of coastal and mangrove areas thus providing financial assistance to partners in implementing this much-needed life-sustaining endeavor;

WHEREAS, there is a need for the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Tagum to pass a resolution requesting the Development Bank of the Philippines for the City of Tagum to enroll in the DBP Forest Project and avail of a financial assistance relative to the implementation of Tagum's Mangrove Reforestation and Aquaculture Development Project due to the magnitude and scope of this major undertaking and initiative of the Local Government Unit.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the 4th City Council of Tagum to request the Development Bank of the Philippines for the City of Tagum to enroll In the DBP Forest Program and secure a funding assistance In the amount of Two Million Seven Hundred Thousand (P 2,700,000.00) Pesos as counterpart funds for the Mangrove Reforestation and Aquaculture Development Program of the City of Tagum.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished to all concerned.
