**RESOLUTION NO. 98, s- 2010**

**“A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE EXECUTIVE – LEGISLATIVE AGENDA (ELA) OF THE CITY OF TAGUM FOR THE TERM 2010-2013.”**

**WHEREAS**, to evaluate the Revised Executive – Legislative Agenda for the Term 2007-2010 and formulate the Executive – legislative Agenda for the Term 2010-2013, a conference was held last June 18 and 19 , 2010 at Agila 2 Function Hall, Waterfront Insular Hotel, Lanang, Davao City and was participated in by the Elected Officials of the City of Tagum and its stakeholders;

**WHEREAS**, after hours of careful deliberation and discussion the group was able to solve issues and concerns related to the past Executive – Legislative Agenda and finally instigated the Executive – Legislative Agenda of the City of Tagum for the Term 2010 – 2013 based on the Consolidated Platform of Government of the elected officials that attune with the emerging development , thrusts and priorities of the City and for the promotion of the general welfare of its constituents;
