RESOLUTION NO. 73, s- 2010

“A RESOLUTION REQUESTING HON. JEJOMAR C. BINAY, VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR THE INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF THE SENIOR CITIZEN PROGRAM UNDER THE SOCIAL WELFARE OFFICE OF THE CITY OF TAGUM.”

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XV, Section 4 of the Constitution, it is the duty of the family to take care of its elderly members while the state may design programs of social security for them. Further, Article XIII, Section II provides: “The state shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods available to all the people at affordable cost. There shall be priority for the needs of the underprivileged, sick, elderly, disabled, women, and children”.

WHEREAS, the local government of the City of Tagum promotes the program for social security through the Office of the Senior Citizen’s Association in partnership with the different Non-Government Organizations (NGO’s) and other business sectors giving priority to the underprivileged, sick, elderly, disabled, women and children;

WHEREAS, the number of the Registered Senior Citizens as of June, 2010 in the city of Tagum is now reaching to Five Thousand Two Hundred Eighty (5,280) Individuals with a provision of more or less 10% increase for every succeeding year;

WHEREAS, a proposed budgetary amount proportioned to the registered number of senior citizen would most likely enhance the work plan for the implementation of this program in relation to the institutionalization of the “ Self and Social Enhancement Services”.

WHEREAS, the rationale behind the promotion of this program is for the general welfare and development of the Senior Citizens and make them more active, participative and productive individual partners in the promotion and progress of the Local Government of Tagum;

WHEREAS, considering the abovementioned premises, it is the humble opinion of this Council that the said request for funds is deemed necessary, beneficial, and practical to request unto the good Office of the Vice-President of the Philippines;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Tagum City to request Hon. Jejomar C. Binay, Vice-President of the Republic of the Philippines for financial support for the institutionalization of the Senior Citizen's Program under the Social Welfare Office of the City of Tagum;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished to all offices concerned for their information and guidance.
