RESOLUTION NO. 1052, s-2010

A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SISTERHOOD TIES BETWEEN THE CITY OF TAGUM AND THE BOLIVARIAN REPUBLIC OF VENEZUELA.

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 333 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the local government units may through appropriate ordinances, group themselves, consolidate or coordinate their efforts, service and resources for purpose commonly beneficial to the concurring parties;

WHEREAS, establishing a sisterhood tie will open the horizon for international friendship that shall be the basis for exchanging initiatives experiences and technical know-how on areas of mutual interest in the promotion of trade, investment, culture, arts and tourism;

WHEREAS, the sisterhood pact will not only strengthen friendship ties but more importantly, institute a working channel of communication in facilitating exchanges of information and technology, programs, urban/rural planning policies and development, socio-cultural activities, income generation and fiscal administration, public education intensification and other important aspect of tourism developments that is beneficial to both government institution thus, leading to its growth and advancement and eventually to self sustainability;

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the City Government of Tagum through our City Mayor Rey T. Uy to establish a sisterhood tie with the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela through His Excellency Manuel Pe'rez Iturbe, Ambassador to the Philippines, in the spirit of goodwill, peace and development;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Tagum City observes no reason not to consider such much needed diplomatic measure favorably endorse the establishment of sisterhood tie between the City of Tagum, Province of Davao del Norte and the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela;

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to favorably endorse the establishment of sisterhood ties between the City Government of Tagum and the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela.
