RESOLUTION NO. 991, s-2009

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. REY T. UY, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN FOR AND BEHALF OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF TAGUM A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE SAGOP PALAD FOUNDATION, REPRESENTED BY FR. ELIGIO BIANCHI FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CHILDREN'S WELFARE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, "the state recognizes the efforts of the non-government organizations in the promotion, protection and rehabilitation of the children and youth, the opportunities to achieve a productive and justifying life";

WHEREAS, Section 35, Chapter 4 of the Local Government Code of 1991, provides: "Local Government Units may enter into joint ventures and such other cooperative arrangements with people's and non-governmental organizations to engage in the delivery of certain basic services, capability building and livelihood projects, and to develop local enterprises, designed to improve productivity and income, diversify agriculture, spur rural industrialization, promote ecological balance, and enhance the economic and social well-being of the people";

WHEREAS, Section 36, Chapter 4 of the same Code further provides that: "A Local Government Unit may, through its Local Chief Executive and with the concurrence of the Sanggunian concerned, provide assistance, financial or otherwise, to such people's and non-governmental organizations for economic, socially oriented, environmental or cultural project to be implemented within its territorial jurisdiction";

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Tagum to authorize the City Mayor, Hon. Rey T. Uy, to enter into and sign for and in behalf of the City Government of Tagum a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Sagop Palad Foundation, represented by Fr. Eligio Bianchi for the implementation of the children's welfare program.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the full text of the Memorandum of Agreement shall be read as

The **SAGOP PALAD FOUNDATION**, with official address at 075 BAG Village, Magugpo East, Tagum City, represented herein by Fr. Eligio Bianchi.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, "the state recognizes the efforts of the non-government organizations in the promotion, protection and rehabilitation of the children and youth, the opportunities to achieve a productive and justifying life";

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Tagum in collaboration with the non-government agencies and people's organization will be responsible in ensuring effective partnership of this endeavor;

WHEREAS, Section 36, Chapter 4 of the Local Government Code provides that: "A Local Government Unit may, through its Local Chief Executive and with the concurrence of the Sanggunian concerned, provide assistance, financial or otherwise, to such people's and non-governmental organizations for economic, socially oriented, environmental or cultural project to be implemented within its territorial jurisdiction",

WHEREAS, the Sagop Palad Foundation, an accredited Non-Government Organization (NGO) is a partner of the Local Government Unit in the promotion, protection and rehabilitation of minors and other disadvantaged children;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereby agreed to fully support the promotion, protection, and rehabilitation of children and youth.

I THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF TAGUM

1. To release the fund taken from the financial assistance to NGO under the Annual Appropriation for CY 2009 for the promotion, protection and rehabilitation of its children and youth, under the institutional care of Sagop Palad Foundation in the amount of Fifty Thousand (P 50,000.00) Pesos.
2. The City Government of Tagum thru the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) will conduct regular monitoring and/or checking of the programs set by the above-mentioned NGO, aim at rehabilitating the youth beneficiaries in accordance with the former role and functions.
3. The City Government of Tagum shall collaborate with the Department of Social Welfare and Development on the effect of the NGO accreditation and licensing as child care institution.
4. The LGU thru its City Social Welfare Department will make referrals with accompanied Case Study Report of the youth-beneficiaries to be catered by the afore-named NGO.

II SAGOP PALAD FOUNDATION

1. Shall sustain its programs and services for the promotion, protection and rehabilitation of its minors or wards referred to this institution by the LGU thru its CSWDO;
2. Shall provide/submit Statement of Expenses to the Office of the City Mayor thru the CSWDO;
3. Shall consider the recommendation of the LGU & CSWDO for the implementation of its program based on the latter's findings and regular monitoring activities;
4. Shall have the right of refusal to accept youths referred to the LGU in cases of exhaustion of funds and/or lacking of case study report.

III EFFECTIVITY

This Agreement shall take effect upon its signing by the parties and shall remain in force as long as the funds are not exhausted or unless terminated by the contracting parties.
